Bids received after that time will not be accepted. All bids will be opened publicly shortly thereafter.

All bids shall be enclosed in envelopes (inner and outer) both of which shall be sealed and clearly labeled with the words "SEALED BID FOR SECURITY CAMERA INSTALLATION, WILKES-BARRE HOUSING AUTHORITY", name of bidder and date and time of bid opening, in order to guard against pre-mature opening of the bid. Facsimile bids will not be accepted or considered. Bidding Documents will be available starting on August 18, 2017, and as Identified below.

The Owner may, at its discretion waive informalities in Bids, but is not obligated to do so, nor does it represent that it will do so. The Owner also reserves the right to reject any and all Bids.

A Bid Bond made payable to the Wilkes-Barre Housing Authority in the amount of 5% of the Base Bid shall accompany each bid, executed by the Contractor and a surety company licensed to do business in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, as a guarantee that, if the bid is accepted, the bidder shall execute the proposed contract and shall furnish and pay for a Performance and Payment Bond in the amount of 100% of the Contract Price as security for the performance of the Contract and payment of all costs thereof, upon execution of Contract.

The successful Bidder will be required to file a Stipulation Against Mechanic's Liens prior to commencing work.

Notice is given that the Contract for which construction bids are being solicited is subject to applicable provisions of the Davis-Bacon Act and appropriate minimum wage rates as promulgated under provisions of said Act must be paid by Contractors in connection with performance of the necessary work.
